Re: Test Results

As you are aware, TLRC nursing staff began testing Health Center and Assisted Living residents last week for COVID-19 as mandated by law. We have now received all the results and two of our Health Center residents' tests have come back positive. Both roommates of these two residents have tested negative, but we will follow established procedures as outlined by CDC and the Washington Department of Health.

Our nursing team have already isolated these two residents. We will continue the protocols already in place and the staff assigned to these two residents will not be assigned to work with any other residents. We are required to isolate these two residents for 10 days after the test was conducted (May 28th). We are already 5 days into this process and expect to move these residents back to their rooms in another 5 days.

We are now beginning the process of testing all TLRC employees and will update you of the results once we receive them. While I know this news is a disappointment for all of us, I ask that you join me in continuing to be proud and appreciative of all the efforts our employees have taken to keep our residents safe and healthy. The systems put into place have served us well and will continue to do so. Staff members have done a fabulous job under trying circumstances and again, our work continues to provide the best and highest quality services possible to all whom we serve.
