Re: COVID-19 Update

As you are most likely aware, TLRC has been conducting routine testing for COVID among our staff as per the Federal mandate that was announced earlier this year. I need to make you aware that we received a positive test result today from one of our Health Center employees. Therefore, per Department of Health guidelines, we are now considered in “Outbreak” mode. This means we are suspending admissions to the Health Center until December 9th at the earliest. Visitations with Health Center residents will also be suspended until December 9th. If additional positive tests come back to us, these dates will be adjusted accordingly.

Please know we continue to monitor this situation closely and are adhering to all regulations. Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) such as masks, gowns, and eye protection are being used routinely and sanitizing of our spaces, equipment and furniture are being done on a regular basis.

I know this may be disappointing news, but I am proud of the fact that throughout the pandemic, based on the number of staff and residents on our campus every day, we have had a very low number of positive cases and I credit this to our staff who are rigorous in making sure all protocols are being followed. They have done a great job!
