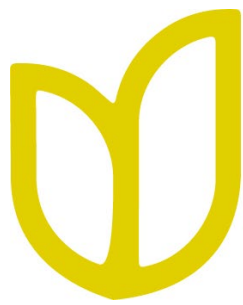

3. Save this form to your computer, email Pet Application and Evaluation Form and Signed Pet Policy to Life Enrichment Department at cclark@eliseo.org and to schedule your pets behavioral evaluation appointment.

On the day of your appointment your pet should be bathed, groomed and on a leash or in a carrier. Please remember to bring this form, all requested pet records and signed pet policy.

Once your pet has passed our behavioral evaluation your pet will be given a pet approved tag. Please have your pet wear this tag whenever you are visiting. When visiting your pet must remain on a leash and or in a carrier. All pet records on file with **eliseo** must be current and in order for you to visit with your pet.



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VISITING PET GUIDELINES & REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- Philosophy -

Animals in Long Term Care facilities have proven effective in enhancing the quality of life for its residents. Therapeutic effects range from sensory stimulation to marked physical and emotional improvements. Through the creation of home-like atmosphere utilizing pets, animals in assisted therapy and visiting pet programs enhance residents' level of responsiveness to the environments and serves as a catalyst for social interaction. By having a visiting pet program, a world of opportunities opens for each individual who have been separated from loved ones and home.

Residents loved ones, volunteers and/or staff bringing pets into this facility must comply with the following guidelines:

To ensure a healthy environment for the visiting pet, your animal must be preregistered with eliseo. Registration includes:

1. Providing a copy of current health and shot records from your veterinarian attesting to good health & behavior Providing a copy of your pets current pet license.
2. All animals must successfully pass a behavioral evaluation. While there is no charge for this evaluation, an appointment must be prearranged with the Life Enrichment Department at 253-284-7525 or 756-7581.
3. All visiting animals must be on a non-retractable leash, or in a carrier while on the property of **eliseo**.
4. All visiting pets must be free of parasites.
5. Your pet must be wearing or, you must have on your person the **eliseo** approved pet tag.

All animals must be housebroken and use appropriate areas for taking breaks. It is the owners responsibility to clean up after their pet.

If you are a returning registered pet visitor, you may not enter the premises if your records are no longer current with us (you must submit updated records to the Life Enrichment Department prior to your visit).

WAC-248-14-570 Pets - States: Animals, except fish in aquariums, shall not be permitted in:

Any area where food is stored or prepared

Any areas during times when food is being served or consumed in group settings (except: seeing eye-hearing ear and assistance dogs are permitted in dining areas as needed)

Any areas where dishes or cooking/eating utensils are cleaned stored

Failure to adhere to any of the aforementioned requirements, will result in refusal to be on the premises with your pet.
