Re: Visitation Update

As shared with you yesterday, our weekly COVID testing resulted in no new cases for the second week in a row. Therefore, we are able to resume many actions that had been shut down due to our outbreak status, which includes visitations in all areas of our campus.

We have been informed by our Local Health Jurisdiction Officer that while we need to operate under Governor Inslee's Safe Start program, we no longer have to schedule visitations. We are resuming our normal visitation hours of 8:00 a.m.-8:00 p.m. seven (7) days per week and you may visit with residents anytime during this time frame. The visitations must take place in the resident's living area (room/apartment). Anytime you are in a public area of the main building, you must wear a mask-no exceptions. You will also be screened at the kiosks or by the Receptionists. After your screening has been completed, we ask that you go directly to the resident's living area and when the visit is finished, please go directly to the exit. We still need to minimize traffic throughout the public areas in order to curtail exposure to COVID. We encourage you to wear your mask while in the resident's living area because if we move into outbreak mode again (defined as more than one new case within a seven-day time frame), we will be forced to stop visitations and all of the other items we reopened today (communal dining, group programming, the Salon and Harbor Café for the Six-Plex residents). COVID remains among us, and we **all** need to work together to keep it from taking hold at **eliseo** again.

Thank you for your understanding with all of this and know we look forward to seeing our visitors again. Welcome home!
