Re: COVID Update

COVID continues to knock on our door and while the updates are much less frequent than they were at this time last year, we are reminded that COVID is here to stay. We had one Health Center resident who discharged home and tested positive after discharge and a Six-Plex resident who has tested positive. The Six-Plex resident is isolating themselves at this time. We currently have three Health Center staff members who have tested positive. The employees were sent home immediately after their test results were confirmed and are not scheduled to return for ten (10) days provided no new symptoms have presented themselves.

Based on the current CDC and Washington Department of Health (DOH) guidelines, visitations and group programming will continue uninterrupted. Admissions will continue in the Health Center. Masks are still required to be worn by all people when in any of the buildings on campus and we encourage you to wear masks when in group settings. In addition, face shields are still required to be worn by all **eliseo** employees when in the Health Center, Apartment building and North Ridge.
