Re: COVID Update

In case you were wondering if COVID has disappeared, the fact that you are receiving this memo indicates the answer is no. Our staff and residents have done a tremendous job in keeping COVID out of our community but sadly that ended today when we had five (5) residents in the Alpine neighborhood of our Health Center test positive. We also had one (1) staff member test positive on Alpine and two (2) residents test positive on the 600 Hall of the Health Center.

Under the current guidelines, due to the number of COVID cases on Alpine, all residents in Alpine will remain isolated for five (5) days and we will designate staff for Alpine only. If no new symptoms present themselves or no additional residents test positive, Alpine will reopen, The same protocol will be followed for the two residents who have tested positive on the 600 Hall, but the Hall will remain open. The staff member will remain at home for five (5) days and if no new symptoms present themselves, they will return to work. Visitations will continue in both areas but the risks associated with the visitation will be explained before the visit occurs.

Please continue to practice social distancing and the wearing of masks to reduce the risk of spreading this virus among our other residents and employees. If you need any additional information or have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact any of our Department Directors.
